Kori Milroy teaches science at Skinner West Classical School, a Chicago Public School on the city's Near West Side. She is a passionate advocate for science education, believing that scientific thinking empowers young people to satisfy their own curiosities about nature. She later attended graduate school at the Illinois Institute of Technology, where she earned a Master of Science Education concentrating in physical science.
